# Public Meetings: January 26 and January 31

"Siting a Replacement Well for Well 3"

Meeting Date and Time: Thursday January 26, 2012 6:30 to 8:30 p.m.

**Place:** Goodman Community Center— 149 Waubesa St.

<u>Project Description</u>. The East Side Water Supply project reviewed the long term drinking water supply needs of the east side. The study recommended that Well 3 be replaced to ensure adequate water supply to the east side for long term domestic water supply needs and community fire protection.

**Next Steps**: The first step in the process is to conduct a property search considering land use and system needs.

<u>Study Area</u>: Generally from the Yahara River on the west to I-90 on the east, to Northport Drive on the north to Cottage Grove Road on the south.

## "Iron and Manganese Filtration for Wells 7 & 8"

Meeting Date & Time: Tuesday January 31, 6:30 to 8:30 pm

<u>Place</u>: Goodman Community Center— 149 Waubesa St.

**Project Description:** Following review of the water supply and water quality needs of the east side, it was recommended that iron and manganese filters be constructed at Wells 7 & 8. Construction of filters will allow these wells to be used to their full capacity.

**Project Location:** Well 7 is located on N. Sherman Ave. near Shabazz High School. Well 8 is located at the west end of Olbrich Park

## **Anticipated project construction schedules:**

- 2013/2014 Well 8 Iron and Manganese Filtration
- 2014/2015 Well 7 Iron and Manganese Filtration
- 2015/2016 Well 3 Replacement
